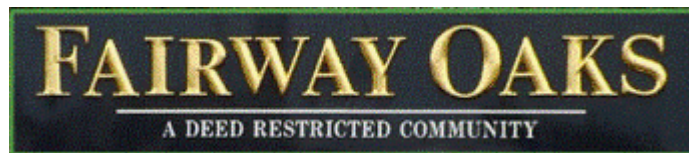
The following Board of Director positions are to be voted on for 2016:

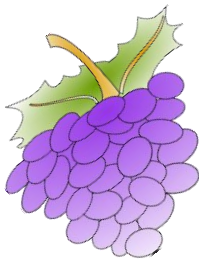

## Recipe of the Month

### Holiday Peanut Butter Cookies

Makes about 4 dozen cookies

Prep 20 minutes

Bake at 375° for 11 minutes

**3 1/4 cups all-purpose flour**

**1 teaspoon baking powder**

**1/4 teaspoon salt**

**1/2 cup (1 stick) unsalted butter, softened**

**1/2 cup creamy peanut butter**

**3/4 cup packed brown sugar**

**3/4 cup granulated sugar**

**2 eggs**

**1 teaspoon vanilla extract**

**1 cup red and green M&Ms**

**1/2 cup peanuts, chopped**

Heat oven to 375°.

Blend flour, baking powder and salt in a small bowl. Beat butter and peanut butter in large bowl until creamy. Beat in sugars until fluffy. Beat in eggs, 1 at a time. Add vanilla.

Next on low speed, beat flour mixture into butter mixture. Stir in 1/4 cup warm water.

Fold in M&Ms and nuts.

Drop by heaping tablespoonfuls onto ungreased baking sheets. Flatten slightly with your hand to form a 2-inch round. Bake at 375° for 11 minutes or until set.

Cool on wire rack.
