PROPOSAL/PETITION:

I have read and agree with the proposal that the County Board of Commissioners adopt an Ordinance requiring The Links Golf Course, Hudson Ave. and Little Road be properly maintained, including mowing the entire area for grass, and controlling the weeds, brush, and undergrowth.

The Links closed in June, 2019 and there is a concern for the safety and welfare of the communities that adjoin the property, including The Estates, The Reserve, Beacon Point, Fairway Oaks, Barrington Woods, Millwood Village, and all residential properties along Hudson Ave. The overgrown golf course negatively affects the home values in our communities plus concerns for storm water problems, snakes, rodents, coyotes, hogs, opossums, armadillos, pollen problems for people with allergies, weed seed invasion into adjoining lawns, etc. The unsightly abandoned golf course has lowered property values and reduced the desirability of our communities - over 700+ homes. The weed filled overgrown land negatively affects not only those homes that adjoin the abandoned golf course but all residents who live in this area, lowered home prices also lowers property tax evaluations.

We encourage you to vote "yes" to help pass the Ordinance to have The Links Golf Course and any other golf course closings be required to mowed and maintained in their entirety.
